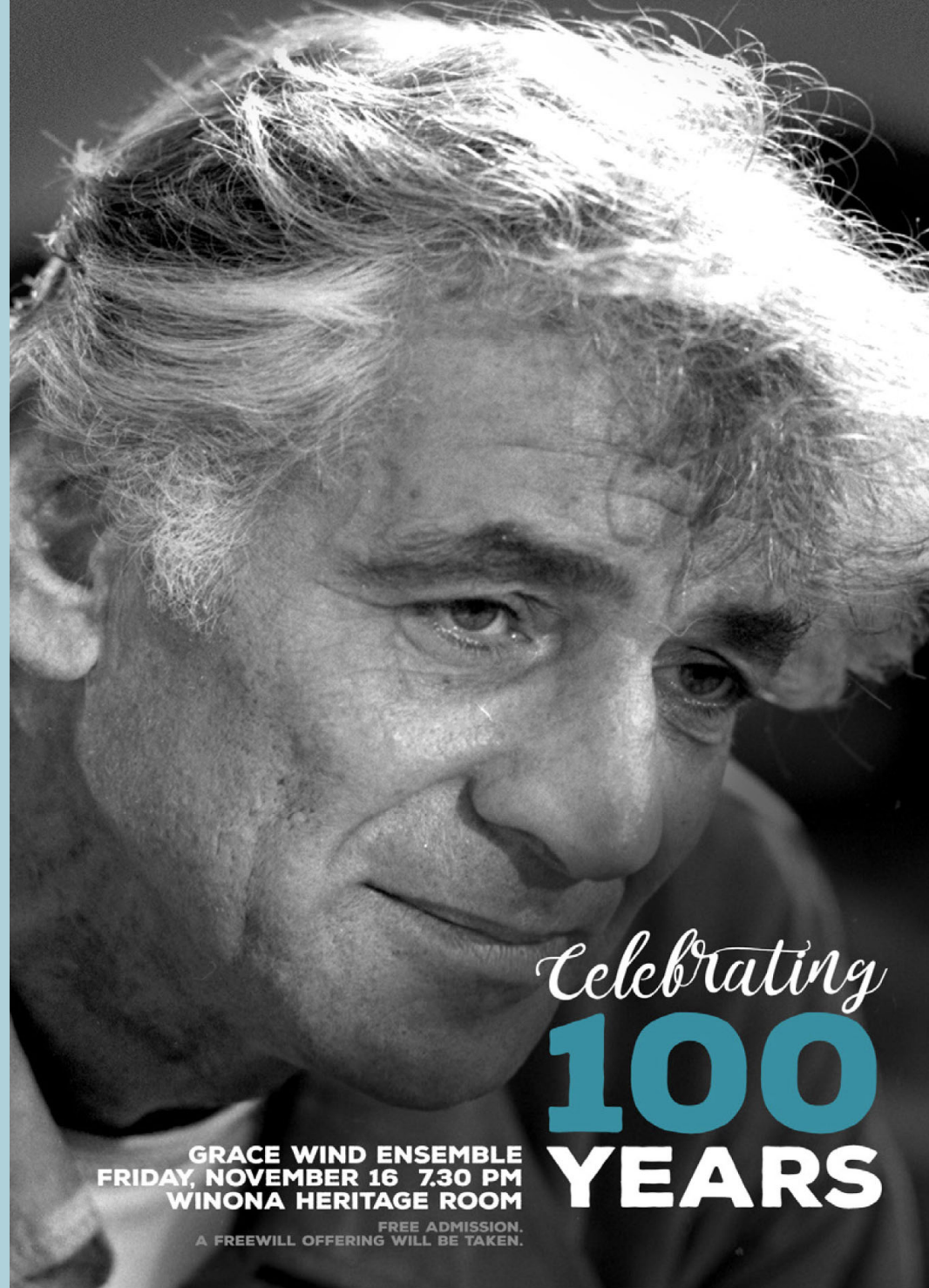

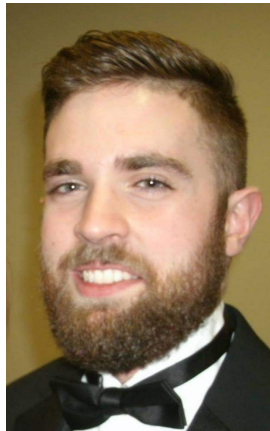
ERIC CRISS
